

## Sandra Faye Thomas August 29, 1944 - February 12, 2016

Sandra Faye Thomas, age 71, passed away Friday, February 12, 2016 in Madisonville, Kentucky at her home.

Sandra was born on August 29, 1944 to Frances Duerson Patton and John Henry Young in Hopkins County Kentucky. She attended Branch Street School and graduated from Rosenwald High School in Madisonville. Sandra worked at the ENRO Shirt Factory, York International, and General Electric. She was a faithful member of Lively Stone Church of God in Christ in Nortonville, Kentucky and was the church pianist for over 40 years until her health failed.

Sandra was married to Fred Thomas on January 16, 1970. They were together until his passing on November 20, 1983.

She leaves to cherish her memory her step-father, Huland Patton, Sr.; one brother, Huland Patton, Jr.; four sisters: Allie Liles, Dorothy Patton, and Mary Patton – all of Madisonville KY, and Vickie Guice of Junction City KS; and a host of aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives, and friends.
